## RULES

All individual licensed amateur radio operators, worldwide, may apply for this award.

A completed application form has to be downloaded from [www.9h1mrl.org/awards.htm](http://www.9h1mrl.org/awards.htm)

Copies of QSL cards (back side is needed) must be submitted for each band. You need eight ( 8 ) different bands confirmed by qsl card to be eligible for this award. Cards should be verified. Two ( 2 ) of the Qso's need to be with 9H1MRL or 9H1MRL /P.

The Name and Callsign will appear on the Award certificate.

The award certificate shall be dated and serial numbered by mode ( PHONE #001, CW #001, DIGITAL MODES #001, MIXED #001 ). Please mention on the Application which Mode you apply.

Your callsign must be verifiable, either on an internet database like QRZ or HamCall.  
Qso's after January 2000 are eligible for this Award.

Bands eligible for this award are :- 160M, 80M, 40M, 30M, 20M, 17M, 15M, 12M, 10M, 6M, 2M .

A fee of €10 for EU and Outside EU should accompany the application, to cover printing and mailing expenses for each award.

### **Minimum information on each QSL:**

Full QSO details.

### **Qso's that count (or do not count):**

Cross band Qso's are NOT counted . Qso's under authorizations other than amateur radio allocations are NOT counted.
